3. How many solutions does $Ax = b$ have for any b in \mathbb{R}^3 (one, none, or infinitely many)? (2 pts.)
4. What is the column space of A ? (2 pts.)
5. What is the determinant of A^{-1} ? (2 pts.)
6. If $AB = 3I$, then what is the determinant of B ? (2 pts.)
